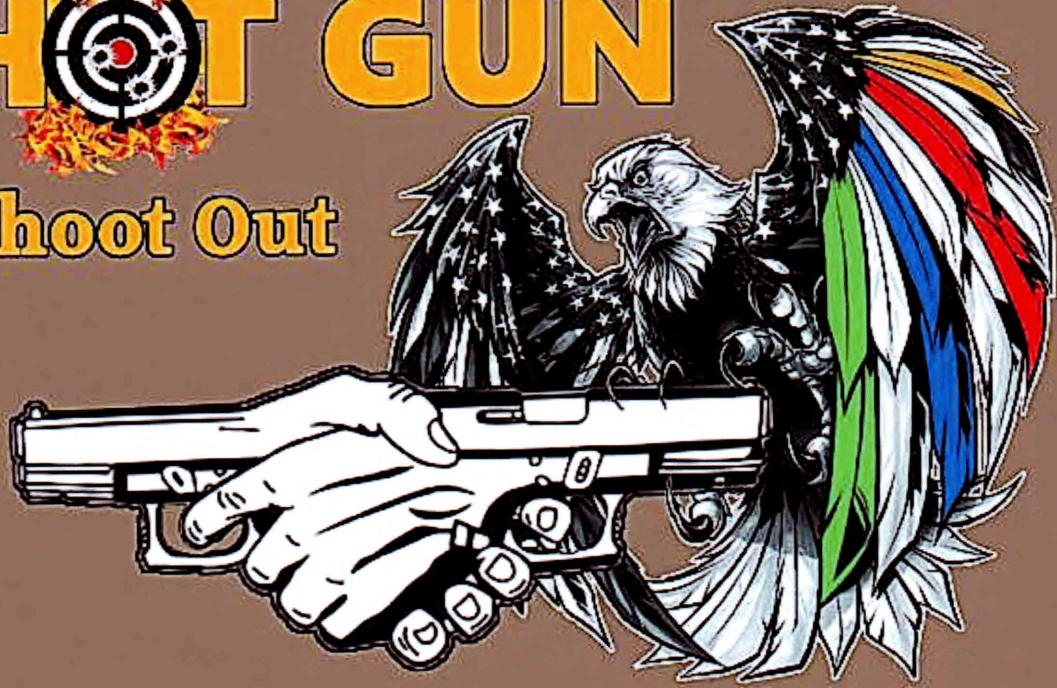

A grand prize trophy will be presented to the top scoring team and will be kept for one year and brought back and defended the next year.

On behalf of Chatuge Gun Club I would like to thank you for participating in the upcoming match on Saturday May 17, 2025. The Proceeds from this match are for the benefit of **The Towns County Fire Dept.**

I would like to go over information you need to know prior to coming to the range on Saturday. Event workers will be arriving at 8:30 that morning and we ask participants to arrive for registration by 9:00. We ask that all that can to please ride together as parking will be on the side of Owl Creek Rd outside of the gun range gate. We will have transportation up to the gate where we will get you signed in and will check all firearms to make sure they are unloaded and safe. **ALL FIREARMS** used in the competition must be bagged or cased and will be moved to a designated area. When called to the firing line you will retrieve your case and proceed to the line where the safety officer will direct you to load and make ready. No guns are to be handled or touched except by command on the firing Line. For the match, you will need 3 magazines with a capacity of 10 rounds each you may keep your magazines on your person throughout the day and we ask that you have them loaded prior to approaching the firing Line.

The firearms are limited to carry type centerfire pistols. Optics are allowed as long as they are fixed to the slide and not the frame. No compensated pistols are allowed. Ammunition is limited to lead, full metal case and jacketed hollow points. No solid copper projectiles allowed due to the danger of ricochet. No ammo which would cause damage to the targets will be allowed.

Please be advised that the targets must fall completely off the rail. In the event that the target turns and is still on the rail, the team must expend all rounds in an attempt to knock the target down. In the event of a malfunction of the target rack, the RSO will determine a hit in the event of a malfunction. There will be a 5 second penalty for any target left standing. Also any stage that has a designated "no shoot" target or targets, there will be a 5 second penalty if the "no shoot" target falls from the rail.

Everyone will shoot all three stages. The second stage will be similar rules except the participants will have (3) ten round magazines rather than the 2 magazines for the first stage.

As a change from last years match, all contestants will compete in all 3 stages with their combined total score being the determining factor in winning.

Each person may shoot on up to 3 teams if desired. All of the teams must be registered and paid by the commencement of the match as there will be no changes after the match begins.

**Each team prior to the start of the match may pay an additional \$50 for the right to reshoot stage one or stage two if desired. The reshoot score will be the prevailing score for the team. Only one reshoot is allowed. Basically, if something causes the team to do poorly on one of the first two stages this gives the team a mulligan.**
