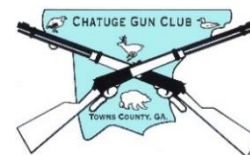



Targets were spread throughout the course for each gun and a bit of thinking was required to keep up with where you were. There were a few targets hidden behind some barrels you had to be careful not to forget. There were some steel targets, some stationery, and some moving pistols. Some ISPC cardboard targets for the rifle portion, some had no-shoots, some had hard barriers. And an arrangement of clays and knockdowns with a popper and a flier.

Third place for the day was shot with a M1 in one stage and a M4 in the other, and a pump shotgun. Brandon Walls was pulling the trigger. Second place was obtained by Mike Claire, with a semiauto tube-fed shotgun, and a PCC. First place was won by Josh Warman with a semiauto mag fed bullpup shotgun and a PCC.
