3-GUN MATCH


13 NOVEMBER 2021


STEEL PLATE DUEL

NOVEMBER 20, 2021

On a crisp invigorating freezing Saturday morning, November 20th, 2021, we had our last Steel Plate duel

for the year. It was our first match with our new steel plates. Steve Evans, who shot with us this day made these plates so a big shout out to him. The plates worked very well but we do see some improvement will need to be made with our rails. With the design



We had 2 sets of rails set up with alternating colors of targets. We also had another rail set up in front with a smaller round plate sitting in front of the opponent's target. This match was designed to require accuracy and speed.

First place for both the rimfire and centerfire was Josh Warman. Audy James was second place in the


Rimfire, and Gene Cooley was 3rd. Mike Clare was second place in the centerfire and Audy James was 3rd.

I had announced some changes with guns next year. There will be no changes to the rimfire class, but I brought a box to the match to show the size limitation for the centerfire.

My goal is to try to make the centerfire bracket more of a match with carry pistols rather

than open class guns. We could possibly move towards drawing from concealment but more on that in the future. Any gun that fits my box is okay to use and a full size 1911 will fit with no problem. Optics are okay if they will fit in the box with the gun and magazine. We will try this but if we need to change it around then I am open to ideas.

It was a fierce competition and I believe most everyone went home happy.



- I've heard too many times "I wish we could shoot this off the bench", so let's do it.
- This is NOT an NRA Approved match
- Lever Action Silhouette, pistol cartridge and rimfire cartridge; Smallbore Rifle Silhouette both standard and hunting rifles.
- 40-Rounds per match.
- All rules will follow NRA guidelines with the exception that it may be shot off the bench with only a front rest.
- Ties will be resolved by shoot-offs consisting of a 5-shot string followed by sudden death if needed at chickens at 100 yards.


