## **BOWLING PIN MATCH**

On January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 we had the first outdoor match of the new year. We asked for cold weather and we got it! I believe it was about 25 degrees as we got started and warmed up to a smoking 50 degrees by the end.

17 people showed up to shoot the first steel plate duel of the season and we had a great time. Because of a shortage of ammunition, we designed this

match to utilize half the ammo normally used and we allowed only 10 rounds for each run. At the beginning of the match, I explained that we were going to go by the adage that Wyatt Earp once used: Speed is

good, but Accuracy is final. That being said, on the rimfire match, 10 targets and 10 rounds. No room for error so speed was a factor, but accuracy was what would win. We also had the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place decided with identical guns. We had them shoot Smith and Wesson 617 revolvers. Dave Hickerson was 1<sup>st</sup>, Matt Van Steen 2<sup>nd</sup> and Thad Bynum was 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The centerfire was slightly different. We used Duane



Mowry's large steel silhouettes again but only had 7 for each shooter. Each shooter also was allowed one magazine of 10 rounds. Six of the targets had to be shot before the stop plate which was a specially marked silhouette. If the stop plate was shot before hitting the previous 6 plates would cause an automatic loss. This created a lot of discussion as we had some really

fast shooters that hit the stop plate a little too early. I had intentionally placed the stop plate in close proximity to the other plates to force accuracy upon this match.

Don't worry shooters, as I will surely find something else exciting to do on the next match. I will also try to make it a little warmer.

The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishers in the centerfire match dueled with matching 45 Colt revolvers.

It was a lot of fun to watch. Centerfire: Josh Warman 1<sup>st</sup> place, Jerome Schreiber 2<sup>nd</sup> and Keith McMahan 3<sup>rd</sup>.

#### CAST BULLET MATCHES ARE BACK

The Cast Bullet BR matches will start 20 March, at 1pm after the Center fire BR matches are concluded. Firearms and Ammunition: Cast Bullet Match: This match is open to any center fire rifle shooting cast lead bullets with iron sights. The course of fire will be 2 targets with 10 rounds on each target fired in 2 relays across the bench using the standard NRA 100 yd target. This has been a very popular match. Old lever actions, trapdoor

Springfields shooting .45-70, et al, are some of the rifles seen during this match. No modern copper jacketed bullets are permitted.

**Accessories**: A. Spotting scopes are permitted but must be placed so that they don't interfere with other shooters. B. Shooting glasses are mandatory. No one will be permitted to participate without acceptable safety or shooting glasses.
