BLACKPOWDER PISTOL

JUNE 18, 2022 MATCH DIRECTOR – GARY CAINES s fantastic for the Muzzla



The day was fantastic for the Muzzle Loading Pistol Match. We were fortunate and had beautiful weather that wasn't as hot as it has been the last few days. Unfortunately, we only had five shooters show up and all were club members.

Initially, the plan was to shoot bullseye targets at 25 yards and 50 yards, single handed and a second 25-vard

permitting two-hand hold. That plan fell through when most shooters had technical problems with their firearms during the practice period that lasted a significant amount of time due to the problems. Shell Traver was shooting a recently purchased Colt replica revolver for the first time and was experiencing issues with nipples plugging and up

while incomplete combustion shooting Pyrodex powder substitute black additionally experienced issues while trying to dismantle the revolver to remove stuck lead balls from the cylinder. He eventually switched to 3F black powder and completed the match with 1/3 of the revolver cylinder out of commission.

Josh Warman also experienced difficulties with his Uberti replica1858 Remington .44 was shot for the revolver that first

Although the revolver functioned flawlessly, it was shooting so high that Josh had to aim at the ground level brace on the target frame to hit the target bull. This was Kentucky Windage to the extreme! Apparently, the front sight was too short for some reason. Amazingly, Josh actually shot very well with such a terrible impediment.

Evervone else had some minor issues as

well. Since the time was passing Keith McMahan fast. suggested we leave out the 50vard match and the two-handed 25-yard match and add a 5 shot match with a goat swinger at ~40 This idea was well vards. received and a lot of fun.

Overall, the match was a success based on everyone having a good time. We added the results of the 10-shot 25-yard

match and the score of the swinger match for the overall results. Gary Caines was the match winner with a final score of 91-1X. Tom Allen came in second with a score of 76. Keith McMahan came in third with 71. Josh Warman followed with 68 and Shell Traver followed with 63. Overall, most of the scores were very close as all the shooters shot very well, considering the problems with firearms.


