This was the third Defensive Pistol Match of the year and we had ten participants. In observance of the 4th of July, the match was centered around teamwork. It has been said that it was the spirit of interdependence, even more so than independence that built our great nation. Our ancestors had to work together, share what they had, and rely on each other when times were tough. Those were the attributes of the three stages of the match.

In Stage 1, the team found themselves facing up-range between two large concrete pillars when they were forced to return fire. They moved

to an appropriate position of cover and engaged the opposing force while there were several innocent bystanders in the area.

Stage 2 found the team seated in a Humvee which became disabled, and they were forced to exit the vehicle. The team moved to the rear of the vehicle and they then found

3-GUN MATCH

17 JULY 2021

A warm July Saturday brought out 9 shooters. The pistol stage incorporated 2 swinger targets activated by a falling steel silhouette. One fast swinger and one slow swinger posed no real threat to our hearty crew.

Since the price of ammunition is still higher than usual, more shooters are opting to use Pistol Caliber Carbines for the rifle stage rather than the standard rifle caliber AR15. Targets were engaged from 30 to 90 yards and weak hand

firing was part of the course of fire. For some a left-handed shot was no problem for a right-handed shooter but others had trouble as they shoot right handed and are left eye dominant.

The shotgun stage incorporated our usual popper activated by the falling steel silhouette. Since we had a case of black clay birds donated by our shotgun shooters from the Wednesday matches, they were used instead of the optic orange.


