Well, another season of Lever Action Silhouette matches is in the books. We will start again in April of 2023. This last match was a double match combined with Hunter Pistol Silhouette due to a tight scheduling of events. We have a lot of different matches during the year and sometimes it is not easy to get all of them on the calendar.

This last match on the 10th was a good day for ducks, we continued to shoot through the at times a heaver then lighter curtain of rain.

We had 10 determined shooters, most shot rifles and pistols, meaning, many trips down range to reset the targets they had successfully taken down. Thanks to Bill Christine for bringing his new golf cart out, it made the soggy walk down to the 100-yard line much easier to setup the ram targets, thank you Bill, it was a huge help.

In a normal Lever Action Silhouette day, a shooter will walk to chickens at 40 meters, pigs at 50 meters, turkeys at 75 meters and rams at 100 yards, 2 times. This last match, combined with



Hunters Pistol Silhouette, added 2 more trips to each animal. The light rain was not a big deal but did make the range a muddy mess.

In the Pistol Cartridge Match, the 2nd AA with 5 in a row chickens and 9 in a row pigs was Nick Hughes, 1st AA with 5 in a row pigs and 5 in a row turkeys, was John Kremski. First AAA with 10 in a row pigs was Josh Warman. The Match Winner with 5 in a row chickens, was Bill Christine. Frank O'Hara also took home a 5 in a row chicken pin.

The 2nd place A class winner in the Smallbore Match was Janet Finnegan, 1st A was Nick Hughes, Bill Christine was the 1st AAA winner and Match Winner with 9 in a row pigs was Josh Warman.
