Saturday November 25th was our 3-Gun last center fire of the year. The weather was a bit brisk, but otherwise beautiful sunny day. Eight shooters came out to try their hand at the course.

There were 9 steel plates on a rail.

including a shoot through, the rotating plate rack, and a moving silhouette for the piston to take aim at. Cardboard silhouettes were dispersed in the backfield, some singles, some doubles, and some with no-shoots were available for the rifles to sight in on. The usual barrage of steel knockdowns, and clay targets, including the flyer were posed for the shotguns to draw a bead on.

Pistols and rifles started with the magazines out and at slide lock. Shotguns started with 5 in the magazine, not chambered and the safety on. Shooters started with whatever gun they wanted

lead with. to Hands were positioned anywhere but on the gun. 5 seconds was added to the time for each target left and/or miss.

After the course was shot twice and the times were added and averaged, Keith McMahan finished with

the 3rd fastest time of the day. Dave Ochs managed to be just a bit quicker, and come in second place, even with a shotgun malfunction. Josh Warman had the fastest set of the day and won 1st place.


